

IN THE MUNICIPAL COURT OF THE CITY OF OXFORD, MISSISSIPPI

GENERAL ORDER

Effective immediately, the Court requires that any defendant whose case is set on a trial docket must personally appear at docket call. Docket call begins promptly at 1:00 p.m. on the scheduled trial date.

The appearance of counsel alone does not excuse the defendant's presence.

Failure of a defendant to appear when the case is called for trial may result in appropriate action by the Court, including but not limited to the issuance of a warrant or other lawful sanctions.

Attorneys are responsible for ensuring that their clients are properly notified of this requirement.

This Order shall apply to all trial settings moving forward and may be attached to trial docket emails and published on the Court's website for notice purposes.
